

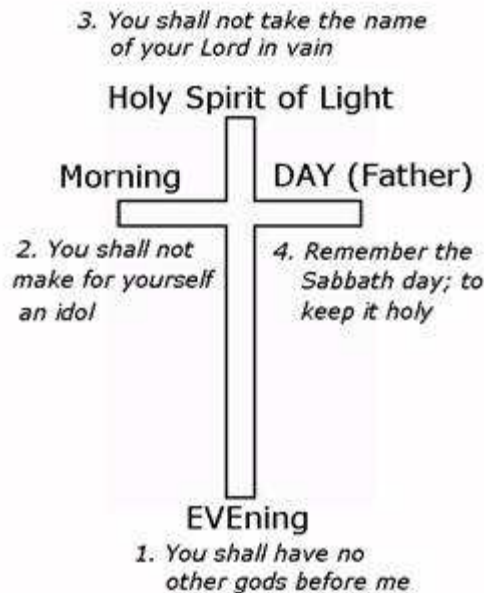
DANIEL: I showed you the fourth Patriarch, Joseph, who had the fourth characteristic of God, time, and so he could see through time and prophecy, unlike other Patriarchs. Likewise, I showed you that Day is the fourth characteristic of God as time eternal. Then what should the instruction for the fourth commandment be for?

THOMAS: According to what you have said, time.

DANIEL: The fourth commandment instructs man to honor time—His time, the Sabbath day. Exodus 20:8:

Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy.

DANIEL: Here is a picture of God's first FOUR commandments: ^(13-21, 22, 23, 24)



THOMAS: How does the third commandment, *not take the name of your Lord in vain*, relate to the Holy Spirit?

DANIEL: Don't you remember Jesus said you must never blaspheme the Holy Spirit, or take Her name in vain, since it would not be forgiven under any circumstances? ⁽¹³⁻²⁵⁾ Jesus was talking about His Mother in heaven, the Most High Holy Spirit of Light.

THOMAS: What about no idol for morning?

DANIEL: The only idol for man sanctioned by God is the Bright Morning Star, who is Jesus His Son. He is your only idol. ⁽¹³⁻²⁶⁾

THOMAS: What about evening with no other gods before me?

DANIEL: Evening is God's first attribute in the order of EVENing, morning, light, and day.

THOMAS: Isn't this the one who you said leads to darkness?

DANIEL: Yes.

THOMAS: How am I supposed to reconcile this attribute of God who leads to darkness to the Trinity? C'mon Daniel.

DANIEL: Evening is the spiritual mother of all flesh and blood, such as you are flesh and blood. If you love yourself, then you should love this side of God and others like yourself in the flesh, just as Jesus said. Can't you see that when you were created in the image of God, this is the part of God who is within you when you are alive, whether or not you are saved?

THOMAS: What do you mean, "Just as Jesus said?"

DANIEL: If only Jesus speaks to your heart, then here:

A new commandment I give unto you, that ye love one another; even as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
