BRIDGE FOR SEVEN NATURES is a second theme of these *sacred occasions*. The bridge can be seen after it is understood that each *sacred occasion* chronologically answers each ordered question of reason for transformation from the original adverse natures. Without speculation, or even manipulation, six questions of reason –WHO, WHY, HOW, WHAT, WHEN, and WHERE position themselves between each corresponding original and transformed nature of mankind. The seventh question of reason, WHICH, demands a choice of two paths; evening to darkness or morning to light. These elements are arranged in chronological order in Figure 6-1 so that their relationship with one another might be made visually clear.
