And when ye sacrifice a sacrifice of thanksgiving unto YHWH, ye shall sacrifice it that ye may be accepted. 22:30 On the same day it shall be eaten; ye shall leave none of it until the morning: I am YHWH. 22:31 Therefore shall ye keep my commandments, and do them: I am YHWH. 22:32 And ye shall not profane my holy name; but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel: I am YHWH who halloweth you, 22:33 who brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I am YHWH.

(C17 Annual Rituals for 7, Pg 1200) Leviticus 23

23:1 And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, 23:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, The set feasts of YHWH, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my set feasts. 23:3 Six days shall work be done: but on the seventh day is a sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation; ye shall do no manner of work: it is a sabbath unto YHWH in all your dwellings. 23:4 These are the set feasts of YHWH, even holy convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their appointed season. 23:5 In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at evening, is YHWH's passover. 23:6 And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto YHWH: seven days ye shall eat unleavened bread. 23:7 In the first day ye shall have a holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work. 23:8 But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto YHWH seven days: in the seventh day is a holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work. 23:9 And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, 23:10 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye are come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring the sheaf of the first-fruits of your harvest unto the priest: 23:11 and he shall wave the sheaf before YHWH, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it. 23:12 And in the day when ye wave the sheaf, ye shall offer a he-lamb without blemish a year old for a burnt-offering unto YHWH. 23:13 And the meal-offering thereof shall be two tenth parts [of an ephah] of fine flour mingled with oil, an offering made by fire unto YHWH for a sweet savor: and the drink-offering thereof shall be of wine, the fourth part of a hin. 23:14 And ye shall eat neither bread, nor parched grain, nor fresh ears, until this selfsame day, until ye have brought the oblation of your God: it is a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings. 23:15 And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ve brought the sheaf of the wave-offering; seven sabbaths shall there be complete: 23:16 even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meal-offering unto YHWH. 23:17 Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave-loaves of two tenth parts [of an ephah]: they shall be of fine flour, they shall be baken with leaven, for first-fruits unto YHWH. 23:18 And ye shall present with the bread seven lambs without blemish a year old, and one young bullock, and two rams: they shall be a burnt-offering unto YHWH, with their meal-offering, and their drink-offerings, even an offering made by fire, of a sweet savor unto YHWH. 23:19 And ye shall offer one he-goat for a sinoffering, and two he-lambs a year old for a sacrifice of peace-offerings. 23:20 And the priest shall wave them with the bread of the first-fruits for a wave-offering before YHWH, with the two lambs: they shall be holy to YHWH for the priest. 23:21 And ye shall make proclamation on the selfsame day; there shall be a holy convocation unto you; ye shall do no servile work: it is a statute for ever in all your dwellings throughout your generations. 23:22 And when ye reap the harvest of your land, thou shalt not wholly reap the corners of thy field, neither shalt thou gather the gleaning of thy harvest: thou shalt leave them for the poor, and for the

sojourner: I am YHWH your God. 23:23 And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, 23:24 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, shall be a solemn rest unto you, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation. 23:25 Ye shall do no servile work; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto YHWH. 23:26 And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, 23:27 Howbeit on the tenth day of this seventh month is the day of atonement: it shall be a holy convocation unto you, and ye shall afflict your souls; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto YHWH. 23:28 And ye shall do no manner of work in that same day; for it is a day of atonement, to make atonement for you before YHWH your God. 23:29 For whatsoever soul it be that shall not be afflicted in that same day; he shall be cut off from his people. 23:30 And whatsoever soul it be that doeth any manner of work in that same day, that soul will I destroy from among his people. 23:31 Ye shall do no manner of work: it is a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings. 23:32 It shall be unto you a sabbath of solemn rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth day of the month at evening, from evening unto evening, shall ye keep your sabbath.

(C18 Pilgrimage of Tabernacles, Pg 1201) 23:33 And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, 23:34 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, On the fifteenth day of this seventh month is the feast of tabernacles for seven days unto YHWH. 23:35 On the first day shall be a holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work. 23:36 Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto YHWH: on the eighth day shall be a holy convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto YHWH: it is a solemn assembly; ye shall do no servile work. 23:37 These are the set feasts of YHWH, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire unto YHWH, a burnt-offering, and a meal-offering, a sacrifice, and drink-offerings, each on its own

day; 23:38 besides the sabbaths of YHWH, and besides your gifts, and besides all your vows, and besides all your freewill-offerings, which ye give unto YHWH. 23:39 Howbeit on the fifteenth day of the seventh month. when ye have gathered in the fruits of the land, ye shall keep the feast of YHWH seven days: on the first day shall be a solemn rest, and on the eighth day shall be a solemn rest. 23:40 And ye shall take you on the first day the fruit of goodly trees, branches of palmtrees, and boughs of thick trees, and willows of the brook; and ye shall rejoice before YHWH your God seven days. 23:41 And ye shall keep it a feast unto YHWH seven days in the year: it is a statute for ever throughout your generations; ye shall keep it in the seventh month. 23:42 Ye shall dwell in booths seven days; all that are home-born in Israel shall dwell in booths; 23:43 that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to dwell in booths, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am YHWH vour God. 23:44 And Moses declared unto the children of Israel the set feasts of YHWH.

Leviticus 24

24:1 And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, 24:2 Command the children of Israel, that they bring unto thee pure olive oil beaten for the light, to cause a lamp to burn continually. 24:3 Without the veil of the testimony, in the tent of meeting, shall Aaron keep it in order from evening to morning before YHWH continually: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations. 24:4 He shall keep in order the lamps upon the pure candlestick before YHWH continually. 24:5 And thou shalt take fine flour, and bake twelve cakes thereof: two tenth parts [of an ephah] shall be in one cake. 24:6 And thou shalt set them in two rows, six on a row, upon the pure table before YHWH. 24:7 And thou shalt put pure frankincense upon each row, that it may be to the bread for a memorial, even an offering made by fire unto YHWH.
