

sojourner: I am YHWH your God. 23:23 And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, 23:24 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, shall be a solemn rest unto you, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation. 23:25 Ye shall do no servile work; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto YHWH. 23:26 And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, 23:27 Howbeit on the tenth day of this seventh month is the day of atonement: it shall be a holy convocation unto you, and ye shall afflict your souls; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto YHWH. 23:28 And ye shall do no manner of work in that same day; for it is a day of atonement, to make atonement for you before YHWH your God. 23:29 For whatsoever soul it be that shall not be afflicted in that same day; he shall be cut off from his people. 23:30 And whatsoever soul it be that doeth any manner of work in that same day, that soul will I destroy from among his people. 23:31 Ye shall do no manner of work: it is a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings. 23:32 It shall be unto you a sabbath of solemn rest, and ye shall afflict your souls: in the ninth day of the month at evening, from evening unto evening, shall ye keep your sabbath.

23:33 And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, 23:34 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, On the fifteenth day of this seventh month is the feast of tabernacles for seven days unto YHWH. 23:35 On the first day shall be a holy convocation: ye shall do no servile work. 23:36 Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto YHWH: on the eighth day shall be a holy convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto YHWH: it is a solemn assembly; ye shall do no servile work. 23:37 These are the set feasts of YHWH, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire unto YHWH, a burnt-offering, and a meal-offering, a sacrifice, and drink-offerings, each on its own

day; 23:38 besides the sabbaths of YHWH, and besides your gifts, and besides all your vows, and besides all your freewill-offerings, which ye give unto YHWH. 23:39 Howbeit on the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when ye have gathered in the fruits of the land, ye shall keep the feast of YHWH seven days: on the first day shall be a solemn rest, and on the eighth day shall be a solemn rest. 23:40 And ye shall take you on the first day the fruit of goodly trees, branches of palm-trees, and boughs of thick trees, and willows of the brook; and ye shall rejoice before YHWH your God seven days. 23:41 And ye shall keep it a feast unto YHWH seven days in the year: it is a statute for ever throughout your generations; ye shall keep it in the seventh month. 23:42 Ye shall dwell in booths seven days; all that are home-born in Israel shall dwell in booths; 23:43 that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel to dwell in booths, when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am YHWH your God. 23:44 And Moses declared unto the children of Israel the set feasts of YHWH.

Leviticus 24

24:1 And YHWH spake unto Moses, saying, 24:2 Command the children of Israel, that they bring unto thee pure olive oil beaten for the light, to cause a lamp to burn continually. 24:3 Without the veil of the testimony, in the tent of meeting, shall Aaron keep it in order from evening to morning before YHWH continually: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations. 24:4 He shall keep in order the lamps upon the pure candlestick before YHWH continually. 24:5 And thou shalt take fine flour, and bake twelve cakes thereof: two tenth parts [of an ephah] shall be in one cake. 24:6 And thou shalt set them in two rows, six on a row, upon the pure table before YHWH. 24:7 And thou shalt put pure frankincense upon each row, that it may be to the bread for a memorial, even an offering made by fire unto YHWH.
