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## 11. Can You SEE the Holy Spirit in the Beginning?

Man was created on the 6th day of the Creation in Genesis I. But there was no man to till the ground in Genesis II. What happened?

Gen 2:5. And no plant of the field was yet in the earth, and no herb of the field had yet sprung up; for Jehovah God had not caused it to rain upon the earth: and there was not a man to till the ground; (ASV)

Genesis 2:5 tells us that the Genesis I creation is a spiritual creation. It is not a physical creation of the earth. Earth was instead waste and void.


- 1 *In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.*
- 2 And the earth was waste and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep: and the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters
- 3 And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. (ASV)

Since Genesis I is a spiritual creation, the Light in Genesis 1:3 is Spiritual Light.

4 And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness.

God saw the spiritual Light as good. It was, therefore, Holy Spiritual Light. And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? none is good save one, [even] God. (Mark 10:18, ASV)

5 And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And there was evening and there was morning, one day. (ASV)
