

4. Can you SEE Paul’s Cross of Judgment?

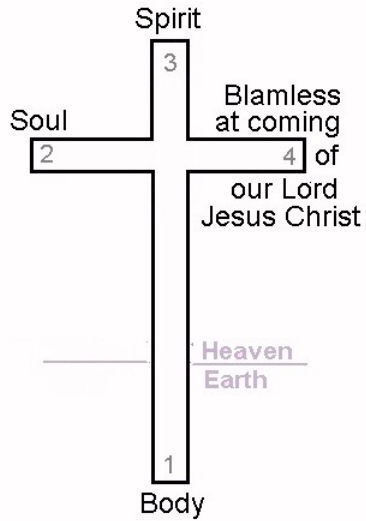
A Picture of the cross is worth more than a thousand words.

The apostle Paul exhorted members of the church at Thessalonica to be always ready for the coming of Christ for judgment, which will be with suddenness and surprise. In particular Paul prayed that they be sanctified *completely*.

According to Paul in order to be COMPLETELY sanctified, all three spiritual attributes of the human, body, soul and spirit, must be sanctified as shown on the “Cross of Judgment” Cross.

"May the God of peace himself sanctify you completely. May your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."

(1 Thess 5:23, WEB)
