3. Can You SEE the Kingdom of Heaven Cross?


Jesus spoke only in parables to the multitudes. One of the shortest and simplest parables was the parable of

leaven:

Another parable spake he unto them; The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven, which a woman took, and hid in three measures of meal, till it was all leavened. (Mat 13:33, ASV)

Leaven (yeast) is used to make both bread and wine such as used in Jesus' last supper. Leaven is the activator for fermentation, which causes the bread dough to rise up and the grape juice to transform into wine. Leaven is the activator for change, like Jesus.

But in both bread and wine the activator must die like Jesus died on the cross—for good purpose.
