

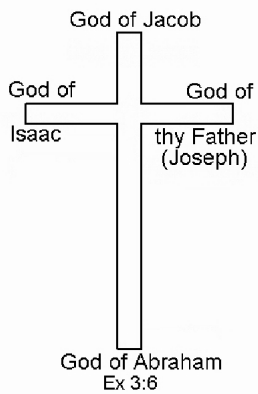
7. Can You SEE God Who Appeared to Moses?

It is written in Exodus that God appeared to Moses and introduced Himself three times: I AM THAT I AM (Four Patriarchs)

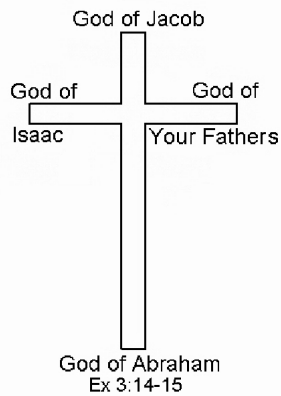
Moreover he said, I am the (1) God of thy father, (2) the God of Abraham, (3) the God of Isaac, and (4) the God of Jacob. (Ex 3:6 ASV)

And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you. And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, Jehovah, (1) the God of your fathers, (2) the God of Abraham, (3) the God of Isaac, (4) the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name forever, and this is my memorial unto all generations. (Ex 3:14-15)

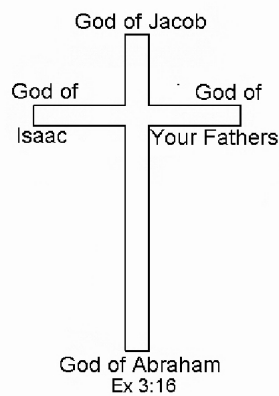
Go, and gather the elders of Israel together, and say unto them, Jehovah, (1) the God of your fathers, (2) the God of Abraham, (3) of Isaac, and (4) of Jacob, hath appeared unto me, saying, I have surely visited you, and seen that which is done to you in Egypt: (Ex 3:16 ASV)

- Question 7:

Do you believe that God (Jehovah) appeared to Moses as four Patriarchs?

Note that Joseph is the fourth Patriarch because Jacob adopted both of Joseph's sons. Joseph is identified as *God of your father* in Genesis 43:23.

And he (Joseph) said, Peace be to you, fear not: your God, and the God of your father, hath given you treasure in your sacks: I had your money. And he brought Simeon out unto them. (Gen 43:23, ASV)
