## 5. Can you SEE God's Purpose Cross?

John 3:16 personifies the Bible in one singe-most important statement—the purpose of God portrayed by "God's Purpose Cross."

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth on him should not perish, but have eternal life. (John 3:16, ASV)

No rearrangement of scripture is necessary to see how the cross perfectly visualizes and teaches John 3:16. The world that God loves is naturally on the foot of the cross, which begins the clockwise rotation around the cross to God's only Son, Jesus Christ, who always occupies the right side as the bridge from earth to heaven. At the top of the cross are all those who believe with their spirit in God's Son, who leads to eternal life on the forth step of the cross with the Eternal

Father in that Day.
