

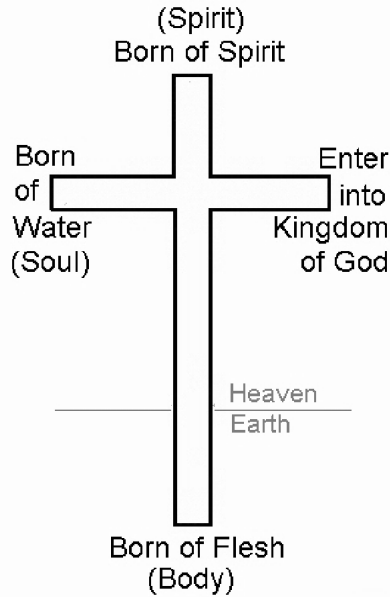
3. Can you SEE Jesus' Cross of Salvation?

A Picture Is Worth a Thousand Words.

Jesus had trouble communicating spiritual things to the Jewish Pharisee, Nicodemus. (John 3:3-4) After Jesus explained to Nicodemus that one must be born anew just to SEE the Kingdom of God, Jesus clarified how one must be born anew to enter the Kingdom of God.

Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except one be born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God! That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. (John 3:5-6, ASV)

Jesus said to Nicodemus on the rooftop you must be born three ways to enter the Kingdom of God. Jesus said you must be *born of the flesh*, and *born of water* to SEE the Kingdom of God. And then you must be *born of the spirit* of the Holy Spirit of Light to *enter into the Kingdom of God.* ^(C4-10)
