## Four Steps for Entry to Kingdom of God

**Observation:** It is written in John 3:5-6 (ASV):

Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except one be born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

Interpretation: Jesus said to Nicodemus on the rooftop you must be born three ways to enter the Kingdom of God. Jesus said you must be born of the flesh (of EVEning, mother of all the living humanity), then born of water of baptism after acceptance of Jesus Christ as

your lord and savior, and then *born of the spirit* of the Holy Spirit of Light to enter the *Kingdom of God*. (C4-10)

## Promise of the Cross 100

**Observation:** It is written in Genesis 12:3,4 and 21:5 ASV *In thee shall* all the families of the earth be blessed (when) Abram was seventy-five years old. Abraham was one hundred years old when his son, Isaac, was born unto him. (100-75=25)

So, the first step of God's promise came true after 25 years.

The second step of promise-25 in the Bible is the number that leads to the Ingathering with God, also known as the Feasts of Booths. On the seventh month the 10th day is the Day of Atonement, and the 15th day begins the Ingathering with God. Together this number is (10+15) = 25.

The third step of promise-25 is written in the Gospel of John. Jesus spoke *truly, truly* 25 times to define the 25-tenet Doctrine of the Gospel of the Kingdom of God.<sup>(C4-11)</sup> This is Jesus' promise that the Holy Spirit would come on the Day of Pentecost, 50 days after his resurrection, since 25 twice (truly, truly) is 50.
