
grew with it, and choked it. Other fell into the good ground, and grew, and brought forth fruitone hundred times."

Fig Tree Cut Down

Observation: Jesus defined the 666 numbers of the first three steps of the Fig Tree Cross in Luke 13:1-16. Jesus' parable identified all those who are not better than those <u>eighteen</u> on whom the tower in Siloam fell and killed them, (13:4) or a woman who for eighteen years had had a

sickness caused by a spirit, (13:11) or a daughter of Abraham as she is, whom Satan has bound for <u>eighteen</u> long years. Jesus said they will perish. (13:16)

Continuing, Jesus defined the fourth step of the Fig Tree Cross in Luke 13:6-9 (WEB):

He spoke this parable. "A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it, and found none. He said to the vine dresser, 'Behold, these three years I have come looking for fruit on this fig tree, and found none. Cut it down. Why does it waste the soil?' He answered 'Lord, leave it




Fig Tree Cross

alone this year also, (fourth year) until I dig around it, and fertilize it. If it bears fruit, fine; but if not, after that, you can cut it down."
