16:3 As for the saints that are in the earth,
They are the excellent in whom is all my
delight.
16:4 Their sorrows shall be multiplied that give
gifts for another [god]:
Their drink-offerings of blood will I not offer,
Nor take their names upon my lips.
16:5 YHWH is the portion of mine inheritance
and of my cup:
Thou maintainest my lot.
16:6 The lines are fallen unto me in pleasant

places;
Yea, I have a goodly heritage.
16:7 I will bless YHWH, who hath given me
counsel;
Yea, my heart instructeth me in the night
seasons.
16:8 I have set YHWH always before me:
Because he is at my right hand, I shall not be
moved.
16:9 Therefore my heart is glad, and my
glory rejoiceth;
My flesh also shall dwell in safety.

Sheol;
Neither wilt thou suffer thy holy one to see
corruption.
16:11 Thou wilt show me the path of life:
In thy presence is fulness of joy;
In thy right hand there are pleasures for ever-

visited me in the night;
Thou hast tried me, and findest nothing;

17:5 My steps have held fast to thy paths,
My feet have not slipped.
17:6 I have called upon thee, for thou wilt
answer me, O God:
Incline thine ear unto me, [and] hear my
speech.
